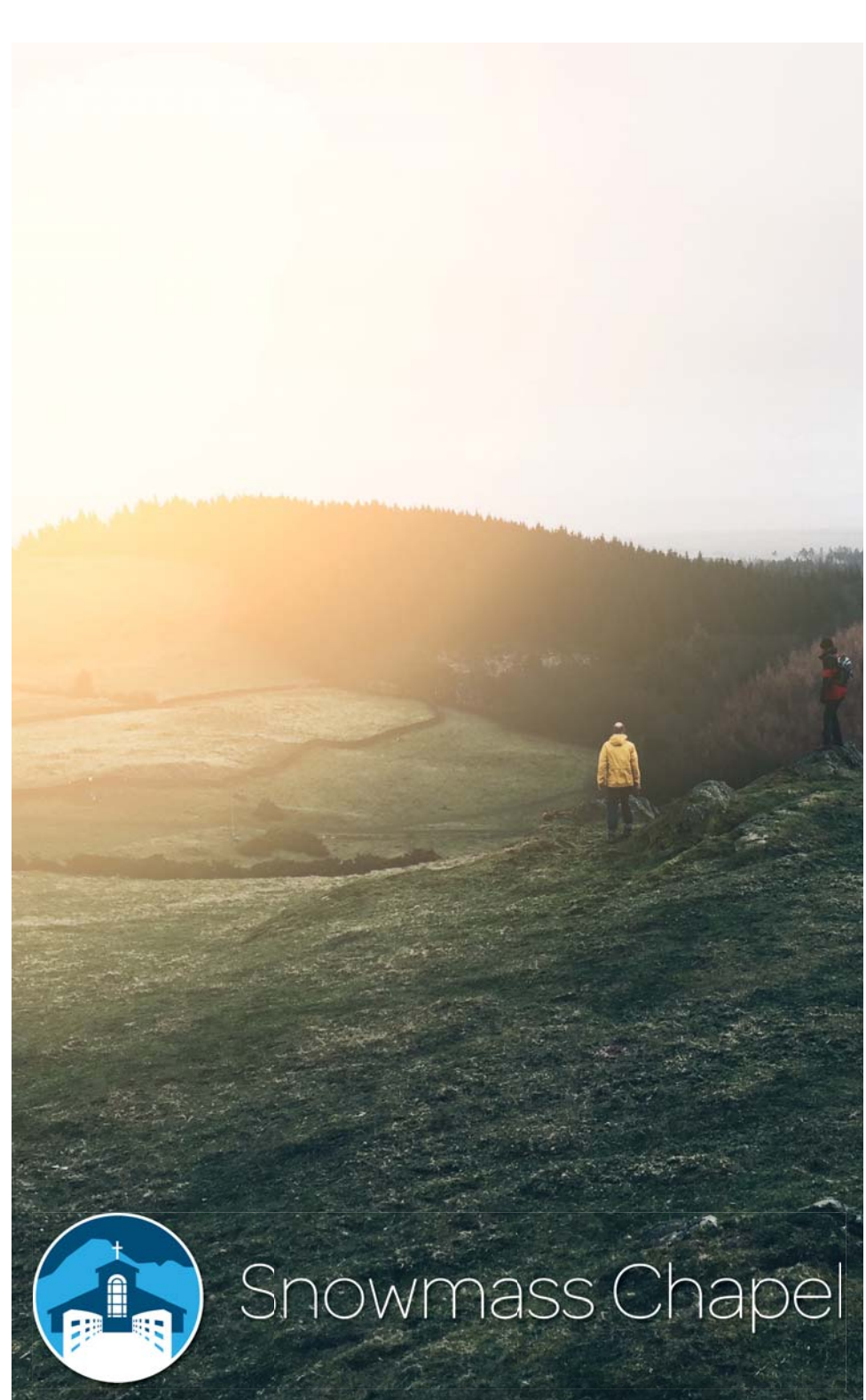

## Guest Musicians

**Brittany von Stein** is the Director of Choirs at Basalt High School and Middle School where she directs the BHS Chamber Choir, Symphonic Choir, the 7th and 8th grade choirs, teaches Music History, Musicianship and Instrument Exploration and leads Maroon Bel Canto Children's Choir through Aspen Music Festival and School. She is very new to the Valley, moving here to teach at Basalt last August. Originally from Sylvania, Ohio, Brittany earned a Bachelor of Music Education with a minor in Vocal Performance and Theatre from The Ohio State University in Columbus, Ohio.



**Katie Hone Wiltgen** is the Director of Education and Community Programming at the Aspen Music Festival and School. Originally from Celina, Ohio, Katie earned a Bachelor of Music degree in Vocal Performance (mezzo-soprano) and Music Education from Miami University (of Ohio) and a Masters of Music in Conducting and Education from Colorado State University. She spent eight years as the Director of Choirs and Bands at Basalt High School and Middle School. In 2010, Katie became a co-founding Director/Conductor of the Maroon Bel Canto Children's Chorus.



**Michael "Micha" Schoepe** studied Musical Theatre Performance in Leipzig, Germany. He played roles in diverse state theatre productions before touring internationally with A Cappella group vocaldente. One of the tours led him to Snowmass Village, CO, where he met his husband Paul Dankers. Micha appeared locally in theatre productions by ACT, Snowmass Chapel and Theater Masters.



**Scott MacCracken** has performed extensively throughout the western slope with Aspen Community Theatre, Symphony in the Valley, the Aspen Choral Society, Aspen Music Festival, and Theatre Aspen in productions including 1776, Chicago, A Little Night Music, Side by Side by Sondheim, and Ballad of Baby Doe, and was seen recently as Juan Peron in Evita. He can be heard around town in such groups as The Local Vocals (do-wop and Christmas carols), and in the Aspen Mountain gondola with Mahatma and the Gondoliers.



**Kyle Jones** is a local pianist and teacher in the Roaring Fork Valley. He currently teaches music at Aspen Middle and High Schools, previously taught in Rifle, and performs and directs up and down the valley for schools, local theater, clubs, and restaurants.

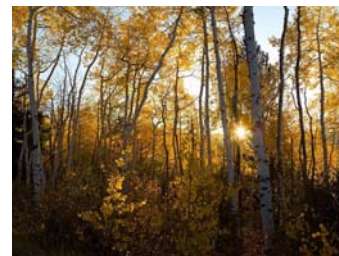
As always, 6th-12th graders are welcome to volunteer in the classrooms and Toddler Room on Sunday mornings (please talk to Coulter to sign up).
