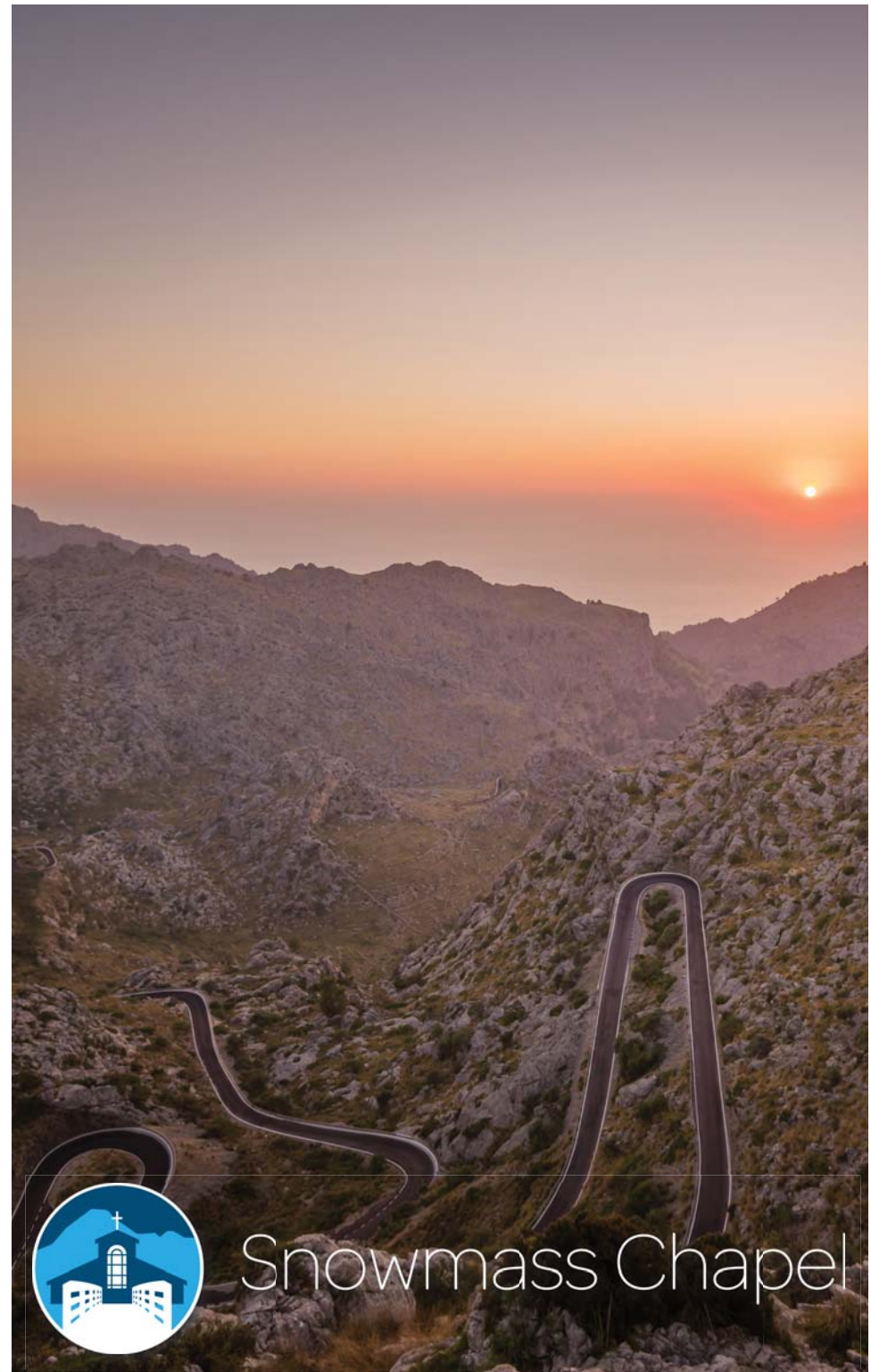

This is the message that the prophet Habakkuk received in a vision.
