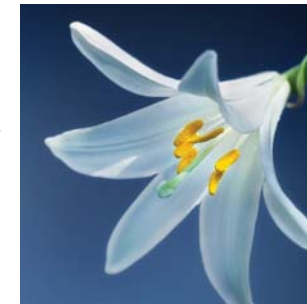
Special Music
