

Today's Scripture Reading

John 14:1-14

14 "Don't let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God, and trust also in me. **2** There is more than enough room in my Father's home. If this were not so, would I have told you that I am going to prepare a place for you? **3** When everything is ready, I will come and get you, so that you will always be with me where I am. **4** And you know the way to where I am going." **5** "No, we don't know, Lord," Thomas said. "We have no idea where you are going, so how can we know the way?" **6** Jesus told him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one can come to the Father except through me. **7** If you had really known me, you would know who my Father is. From now on, you do know him and have seen him!" **8** Phillip said, "Lord, show us the Father, and we will be satisfied." **9** Jesus replied, "Have I been with you all this time, Phillip, and yet you still don't know who I am? Anyone who has seen me has seen the Father! So why are you asking me to show him to you? **10** Don't you believe that I am in the Father and the Father is in me? The words I speak are not my own, but my Father who lives in me does his work through me. **11** Just believe that I am in the Father and the Father is in me. Or at least believe because of the work you have seen me do. **12** "I tell you the truth, anyone who believes in me will do the same works I have done, and even greater works, because I am going to be with the Father. **13** You can ask for anything in my name, and I will do it, so that the Son can bring glory to the Father. **14** Yes, ask me for anything in my name, and I will do it!"


LET'S JOIN VOICES FOR PENTECOST!


NEW ARTWORK IN CREEKSIDE ROOM!
