## Today's Scripture Reading

### Matthew 10:37-42

<sup>37</sup>Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me; and whoever loves son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me; <sup>38</sup>and whoever does not take up the cross and follow me is not worthy of me. <sup>39</sup>Those who find their life will lose it, and those who lose their life for my sake will find it. <sup>40</sup>Whoever welcomes you welcomes me, and whoever welcomes me welcomes the one who sent me. <sup>41</sup>Whoever welcomes a prophet in the name of a prophet will receive a prophet's reward; and whoever welcomes a righteous person in the name of a righteous person will receive the reward of the righteous; <sup>42</sup>and whoever gives even a cup of cold water to one of these little ones in the name of a disciple—truly I tell you, none of these will lose their reward."

## Sermon Notes

July 2, 2017

### A New Zip Code

1. Zip codes vary culturally, attitudinally, politically, economically, socially, etc. Where we live affects who we are, what we think, how we feel, act and relate to others.
2. Matthew Chapter 10
  - a. Jesus is God and the flesh, comes from God. Might say Jesus comes from a very special zip code. Everything he did and said reflect his zip code.
  - b. If Jesus our primary love? Are we willing to find stability and security in Him? Will we seek our core identity in Him? Will we welcome all others?
3. Matthew 22.
  - a. If we want to reflect Jesus' zip code in our lives, first and foremost called to love God and love people. Love is the point, the purpose, and the fulfillment of everything scripture says.
4. Being right versus loving.
  - a. Those who opposed Jesus were the most religious and were far more concerned about being right than loving. Jesus focused on the heart of biblical law, not the literal letters of the law.
  - b. Often when we do what is right we are also doing what is loving, but sometime when we focus upon being right we lose sight of what is most loving and love is the standard to which Jesus call us.
5. How to love God and others. Types of love.
  - a. God is love. See 1 John. Love comes from God. No love, no God. No God. No love. Everything hinges on God and therefore love.
  - b. Eros. Romantic, sexual love. Can be selfish and self-centered emotion.
  - c. Storge. Love that comes from familiarity. Communities.
  - d. Phialial. Platonic brotherly love of great pals.
  - e. Agape. Unconditional love that comes from God. Love to which we are called to love God and people. Only comes from a relationship with God. Is the nature of Jesus' zip code.
