STEPHEN MINISTRY

There are times when every person experiences difficulties in life. These can include death of a loved one, job loss, cancer, hospitalization/illness, loneliness, discouragement and many other struggles. God never intended for us to go through these experiences alone. That's why God brings us together as a congregation – and why Snowmass Chapel has a Stephen Ministry.

Stephen Ministers are men and women from the Chapel who have completed 50 hours of training to care for people experiencing a crisis or simply going through a tough time. Please let one of our Stephen Ministers walk with YOU through your challenges. Care receivers meet with their Stephen Minister privately and confidentially on a weekly basis at no cost for as long as needed. Stephen Ministers listen, care, encourage, support and remind you of Christ's presence in your life. One care receiver commented on "how powerful the Stephen Ministry is in bringing hope, healing and even laughter into difficult circumstances."
