Snowmass Chapel is enthusiastically committed to serving the children, teens, and families of our valley.

We have been blessed to have Coulter Burch's leadership over the past three years, and are blessed that despite him accepting a full-time position that will leverage his MSW degree, he will remain an active part of our congregation and a part-time member of our staff. We are thrilled for Coulter!
