

Chan Mi Jean, is an emerging chamber musician, vocal pianist, and opera coach who has performed internationally in Austria, Canada, China, Czech Republic, Italy, Thailand, and the U.S. She was the apprentice coach for the Virginia Opera in 2017-18 and recently appointed a Lecturer in Music for Collaborative Piano at the University of Tennessee at Martin.



As an active chamber musician, Ms. Jean has performed with various instrumentalists on a wide range of repertoire and appeared in venues such as Aspen Music Festival and the pianist for the prestigious Perlman Trio in 2016- 17. She was also the winner of the 2016 Irving Shain Woodwind-Piano Duo Competition with oboist Emily Knaapen.

Additionally, Ms. Jean has established herself as an opera coach through years of training, and worked on many operas in Europe and the U.S. with world renowned conductors such as David Effron, Jane Glover, Andrew Bisantz, and Ari Pelto. She was a recipient of the Opera Coach Fellowship for Aspen Opera Center for one of the mainstage shows La Clemenza di Tito in summer of 2017 with the invitation for the same position for Trouble in Tahiti in 2018.

A native of Seoul, Korea, Ms. Jean earned her Master of Music and Performer Diploma in Piano Performance from Indiana University and Doctor of Musical Arts in Collaborative Piano from the University of Wisconsin-Madison. Ms. Jean's teachers include Donald Zent, Jean Louis-Haguenaer, and Martha Fischer.

Shelley Warren has over 26 years of experience as a Professional Flutist. She has a Bachelor of Music/Performance Degree from Northwestern University and a Master of Music/Performance Degree from Baylor University, and has been Professor of Flute at Barry University in Miami, Florida, Broward Community College in Ft. Lauderdale, and Mesa State in Grand Junction, Co, compiling more than 20 years teaching at the University level. She has performed in music festivals around the world and in over 65 musicals. Shelley is currently Principal Piccolo in the Grand Junction Symphony, and plays in 7 chamber ensembles that bring live music to all the elementary schools in Grand Junction each year through the Symphony's Springfest Program, and she teaches and performs throughout the Western Slope.



Shelley is also a Licensed Massage Therapist (MA#11819), Certified TRAGER Practitioner, Certified Manual Lymphatic Drainage/Complete Decongestive Physiotherapist, Reconnective Healing/Reconnections Therapist and Reiki Master with over 16 years of experience.
