Snowmass Chapel is once again supporting the community Holiday Baskets program, which has provided new gifts and food gift cards for people in need in our valley since 1981. Holiday Basket recipient families live from Aspen to Glenwood Springs and are referred to the program by local social service agencies. This year, with many people still out of work or working fewer hours, there are more families than ever for whom the Baskets will be their only Christmas celebration.

Will you and your family consider sharing the love with a Holiday Basket this year?

- **Adopt a Family:** The process has been simplified! Buy & wrap new gifts for children only, (unwrapped) gift cards for those over age 17. Large families often have trouble getting adopted so consider partnering with others to so they are not left out this Christmas. Detail on all adoptable families can be found at the Welcome Wagon. Return the (provided) bag of family gifts/gift cards to the Chapel by Sunday, December 1st.
- **Gift Tags:** Select a gift tag from the Giving Tree in the Creekside Room. Bring the new, unwrapped gift to the Chapel by December 1st.
- **Donate:** Make a tax-deductible contribution to Holiday Baskets, PO Box 2192 Basalt CO 81621. The program provides food gift cards for individuals and gifts for those who are not adopted.
